## **Month of the Military Child**

Below are some fun facts about Month of the Military Child. How many of these did you already know?

- There are approximately 2 million military children between the ages of newborn and 18, 1.3 million of them being school-aged
- In 1986 Secretary of Defense, Caspar W. Weinberger designated each April as "The Month of the Military Child".
- "Purple Up! For Military Kids" will be celebrated on Friday April 21<sup>st</sup> this is the day for communities to wear purple and show support and thank military children for their strength and sacrifices.
- Purple symbolizes the combines colors of all branches of the Military-Army green, Coast Guard blue, Air Force blue, Marine red and Navy blue.
- The official flower of the military child is the Dandelion. The plant puts down roots almost anywhere and it's almost impossible to destroy.
