School Bus Safety

Walk with your kids to the bus stop and wait with them until it arrives. Riding the school bus for the first time is a big step for your child. Help your kids get a gold star in school bus safety by following these tips. Teach kids to stand at least three giant steps back from the curb as the bus approaches and board the bus one at a time. Teach kids to wait for the school bus to come to a complete stop before getting off and not to walk behind the bus. If your child needs to cross the street after exiting the bus, he or she should take five giant steps in front of the bus, make eye contact with the bus driver and cross when the driver indicates it's safe. Teach kids to look left, right and left again before crossing the street.

FRIENDLY REMINDER BASE HOUSING PET RULES:

- Review your lease for all pet policy information.
- Residents must notify the management office within (5) days of acquiring a new pet.
- Pet owners must provide proof of updated immunization records along with your pet's photo to the Bolling Family Housing Office.
- Resident is responsible for keeping the grounds clean and sanitary. All yards and must be kept clean of pet droppings. Resident must pick-up and properly dispose of animal waste.
- Pets must be on a leash at ALL times when outside of the fenced area of the housing unit. Pets shall not be tethered outside of the home. Pets must be in the home or behind an approved fenced area in the back yard if unattended.
