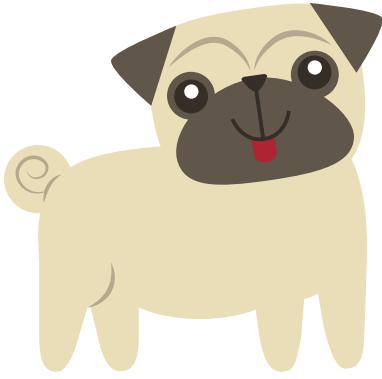

The Fur Baby Corner



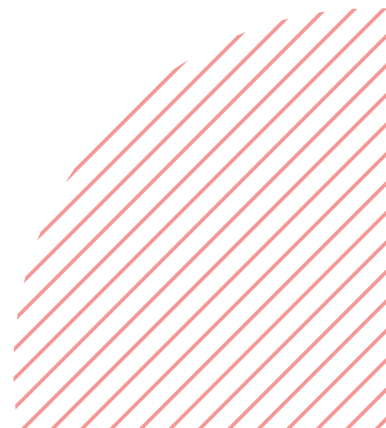
Baby It's Cold Outside!

Never let your dog off the leash, especially during a snow storm, dogs can easily become lost. More dogs are lost during the winter than during any other season, so make sure your dog always wears I.D. tags.

Thoroughly wipe off your dog's legs, paws, and stomach when they come in out of the sleet, snow or ice. They can ingest salt, antifreeze, or other potentially dangerous chemicals while licking their paws, and paw pads may also bleed from snow or cold concrete.

Never leave your dog or cat alone in a car during cold weather. A car can act as a refrigerator in the winter. Keep your cat inside. Outdoors, felines can freeze, become lost or be stolen, injured or killed. Cats who are allowed to stray are exposed to infectious diseases, including rabies, from other cats, dogs, and wildlife.

During the winter, outdoor cats sometimes sleep under the hoods of cars. When the motor is started, the cat can be injured or killed by the fan belt. If there are outdoor cats in your area, bang loudly on the car hood before starting the engine to give the cat a chance. Let's all work to keep our fur babies safe and happy. Happy New Year.

Friendly reminder - Rent is due on the 1st of every month. Rent received after the 5th of the month will have late fees added per the lease agreement.

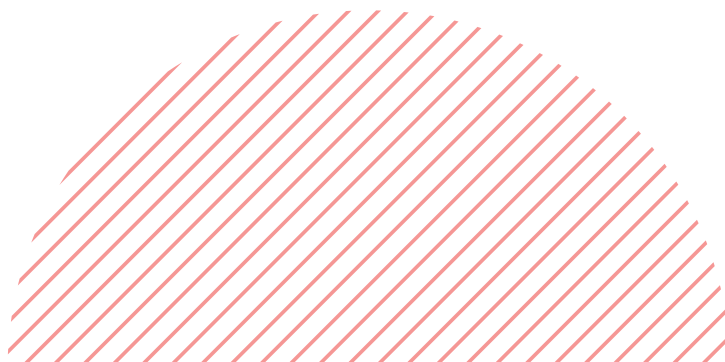
