shift. 60 police officers went to sleep in preparation for morning patrol. 8 paramedics went to sleep in preparation for the morning shift. They all died heroes. The one thing we can all do is recognize their lives were not lost in vain. I ask you to join me in vowing to "never forget" and to continue living our lives stronger and more unified.

COMMUNITY VIOLATION REMINDER



Bikes, toys, basketball hoops, and lawn equipment, when not in use, should be moved to the back yard or garage.



Trash bins may not be left at the curb.



Resident are responsible for the mowing, raking, and trimming of shrubs inside fenced-in area.



All window blinds that have been provided must remain in place and should always be maintained in good condition. Blind replacement services are available for purchase.



Trampolines should be on a flat surface and compatible in size to the homes' fenced-in area. Swings are only permitted in fenced-in areas.



All grills must be used a minimum of 25 ft. from any building structure or combustible source and must be properly stored after use provided the charcoal is completely extinguished, the gas fire is out, and/or the propane is turned off. Fire pits and chimineas of any kind are strictly prohibited.
