We are excited to announce our collaboration with TRO Energy Solutions, Inc. (TROES), to introduce a pilot program for Electric Vehicle (EV) charging in select communities. This program will provide in-home Level-2 EV charging to military housing residents, aligning with our commitment to sustainability and energy resiliency goals outlined by the Office of the Secretary of Defense.

Our pilot program will kick off at four of our military bases: Barksdale Air Force Base (Shreveport, LA), Fort Sam Houston (San Antonio, TX), Joint Base Pearl-Harbor Hickam (Honolulu, HI), and Marine Corps Base Hawaii (Kailua, HI). These locations have been selected to cater to the growing interest in Level-2 fast charging among residents in military housing communities.

This initiative aims to position HMC as one of the pioneering military housing operators in the U.S. to offer a comprehensive residential EV charging solution, demonstrating a forward-thinking approach to sustainability-focused infrastructure.

With Spring Around the Corner

Grilling season won't be far behind! Be sure to read our Grilling safety tips. **Resident Guidelines**

- The use of gas-fired and charcoal barbecue grills inside garages, on decks, balconies, covered parking areas or patios and under any building overhang is strictly prohibited.
- All grills must be used a minimum of 25 feet from any building structure or combustible source.
- Fuel bottles (propane) from the gas-fired grills (attached or unattached) may be stored inside the garage. Do not store these bottles inside the structure.
- All grills may be stored in garages, on porches, decks, balconies and patios, provided the charcoal is completely extinguished or the gas fire is out and the propane is turned off.

Propane Grills

- Use Propane Grills outdoors only.
- Place grill away from home, deck railings, leaves and overhanging branches.
- Check the propane tank hoses for leaks annually.
- If smelling propane while cooking, shut off the gas valve immediately.
- Ensure grill lid is open before lighting.
- Never use accelerants like lighter fluid or gas.
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease buildup.
- Store cylinders outdoors in an upright (vertical) position.
- Never leave grill unattended.
- Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

Charcoal Grills

- Use charcoal grills only outside, away from home and deck railings, and clear of leaves and branches.
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill.
- Choose safe charcoal starting methods like chimney starters or electric starters, avoiding starter fluids.
- If using starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid, keeping it away from kids and heat sources.
- Electric charcoal starters should be used with outdoor extension cords.
- After grilling, let coals cool completely before disposing of them in a covered metal container at least 10 ft from any building.
- Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

SPRING REMINDERS

If a fire or emergency occurs, call 202-433-3333 and provide the dispatcher the nature of the emergency, location of the emergency, your name, and call back number.

MAINTENANCE CORNER

IMPORTANT UPDATES

The below will go into effect on January 1, 2024. Some of the terms may vary from the current, published Hunt Resident Guidelines. For further clarification, below you will find additional details on the operational procedures:

- Maintenance
 - All maintenance requests shall continue to be routed through the neighborhood management offices. The prioritization and response times may differ from those in the Community Guidelines. Any change is intended to enhance the service provided to residents.
 - Definitions of Work Order Priorities:
 - i. Emergency work is classified as a service request that requires mitigation of a hazard in order to prevent immediate damage to the asset or threat to the life, health or safety of occupant.
 - ii. Urgent work is classified as a service request that requires mitigation of a condition in order to prevent a risk that if left unaddressed could over time escalate to damage to the asset or an immediate threat to the life, health, or safety of the occupant.
 - iii. Routine work is classified as any service request that does not qualify as Emergency, Urgent, or Preventative Maintenance work orders.
 - Permission To Enter: Permission to enter is not required for Emergency or Urgent service requests.
 - Submission of Work Orders:
 - i. Emergency and Urgent service requests: the Resident may submit by phone or in person.
 - ii. Routine service requests: the Resident may submit via phone, in person, through the online resident portal, or online mobile application.
 - Loss of Heat:
 - i. Emergency Outside Temperature is 55
 - Degrees or Below at the time of the call. ii. Urgent – Outside Temperature is above 55
 - Degrees at the time of the call.Loss of Air Conditioning:
 - i. Emergency Outside Temperature is 85
 - Degrees or above at the time of the call.ii. Urgent Outside Temperature is below 85 Degrees at the time of the call.
 - Wildlife/Reptiles: Those outside of the home, there will be no work order created. The Air Force will provide points of contact and phone numbers to Hunt, at which time, Hunt will notify the Air Force of the concern.
 - Locked Out occupants:
 - i. During business hours, you will be asked to come to the office to have a duplicate key issued.
 - After Hours: Work Orders will be prioritized as an Emergency.
 - All tenants with a Lease Date or Renewal after January 1, 2024: Locked out occupants will incur a service fee for all Lock Outs occurring after business hours. The first lock out, the resident will incur a \$100.00 service fee. Each additional lock out service request following the initial, the fees will increase by \$25.00 accordingly: Schedule First Lock Out \$100.00

Business Hours.

 Business hours are 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.
