COMMUNITY UPDATES

Fireworks Safety: Know your <u>local fireworks laws</u>. Each state has its own laws regarding the type of fireworks you can set, the dates and times they can be used, who can purchase them, and whether you need a permit. Some states don't allow consumers to use them at all, so make sure you know and follow local guidelines.

Fireworks are strictly prohibited in the Bolling Community and on base.

Here are some additional items to remember:

- Never allow young children to handle fireworks. If using sparklers, supervise children closely and don't allow kids to wear loose-fitting or baggy clothing to handle sparklers.
- Never hold a lit firework in your hand, and never try to relight a malfunctioning firework or "dud."
- Keep spectators at least 35 feet from fountains and ground-based fireworks and 150 feet from aerial fireworks.
- Don't allow anyone who has consumed alcohol to handle or light fireworks or who is impaired in any way.

- **Smart Loading = Better Cleaning:** Make sure dirty surfaces face the spray arms and try not to overcrowd. Good water flow means cleaner dishes!
- **Use the Right Detergent:** Stick with dishwasher-specific detergent and avoid using too much—it helps prevent residue and keeps things squeaky clean.
- Show the Filter Some Love: Check and clean the filter regularly. It only takes a minute and helps stop odors and blockages before they start.
- Freshen Up Monthly: Run an empty cycle with vinegar or a dishwasher cleaner once a month. It gets rid of buildup and keeps your machine smelling fresh.
