Bolling Family Housing Freeze Alert

Dear Valued Residents,

We hope that you are staying safe and warm during the winter weather. Below are some tips for your home and family during the inclement weather.

In an effort to avoid frozen or broken water pipes, we ask that you keep one of your faucets, such as your kitchen faucet, on a slow drip.

Please leave your cabinet doors below your kitchen and bathroom sinks open, to ensure they receive warmth from the air flowing through your home.

Please do not lower the thermostat below 65 degrees when leaving your home for the day or an extended period of time. Due to the extremely cold weather and heavy freezing, the heat in your home must be kept on at all times.

Please do not shut off the heat for any reason. Turning off your heat can cause pipes to freeze or burst, and the heat system to fail.

Keep cabinet and closet doors located on the outside walls closed as they can leak air.

Stay up-to-date with the weather forecast by watching the local news.

Baby It's Cold Outside!



Never let your dog off the leash on snow or ice, especially during a snow storm, dogs can lose their sent and easily become lost. More dogs are lost during the winter than during any other season, so make sure your dog always wears I.D. tags.

Thoroughly wipe off your dog's legs and stomach when they come in out of the sleet, snow or ice. They can ingest salt, antifreeze, or other potentially dangerous chemicals while licking the paws, and paw pads may also bleed from snow or cold concrete.

Never leave your dog or cat in alone in a car during cold weather. A car can act as a refrigerator in the winter. Keep your cat inside. Outdoors, felines can freeze, become lost or be stolen, injured or killed. Cats who are allowed to stray are exposed to infectious diseases, including rabies, from other cats, dogs, and wildlife.

During the winter, outdoor cats sometimes sleep under the hoods of cars. When the motor is started, the cat can be injured or killed by the fan belt. If there are outdoor cats in your area, bang loudly on the car hood before starting the engine to give the cat a chance. Let's all work to keep our fur babies safe and happy. ***Don't forget to stop by the Bolling Family Housing Office to pick up a treat for your Fur Baby.**
