As we welcome a new year and a new decade, I want
 to take this opportunity to restate our commitment
 to our residents. Over the past year, we have been
 working diligently to rebuild your trust, by doing
 some "big things", such as adopting the "Hunt
 Standard" for resident-initiated service requests and
 rolling out a mobile application for residents to
 submit and track work orders in real-time. But we
 have also done the "little things," in comparison –

those actions that receive less attention, but can impact our residents' lives.
 One example is our "Hunt Heart" program. This program is designed to
 address the needs of our new residents, deployed spouses, recently returned
 spouses, those suffering a family crisis, and those who may be in need of
 information about or access to social services through military or civilian
 sources. For example, we provide extra maintenance assistance to deployed
 spouses when requested, such as removing a Christmas tree, mowing a lawn,

 made over the past year, our work is far from done. We hope that you are
